Purpose	To train parents and caregivers to overcome any reluctance to act in emergency situations and to recognize and care for life-threatening respiratory or cardiac emergencies in infants and children

Learning Objectives	Identify how to reduce the risk of injury to infants and children Learn how to care for an infant or child who stops breathing Learn how to care for an infant or child who is choking Learn how to give CPR to an infant or child whose heart has stopped beating Identify how to use your community's emergency medical services (EMS) system effectively
